The mission team was sent to Egypt and Israel from the 26th of October through the 7th of November. We arrived in Cairo, Egypt and entered Israel from Eilat via Mt. Sinai, staying 5 nights in Galilee and 3 nights in Jerusalem. We had most blessed time along the Sea of Galilee with the presence of the Lord which was deep enough to sink into our hearts. We had more rain in this trip than we had had ever before, and had so many rainbows and various types of colored clouds and thunders as even the Israeli tour guide was so surprised with them. We were surely sent there in the midst of the rain of grace.

In Japan schools and most of the companies start their new year in the month of April. The Lord told our church to make the month of November the beginning of a new year, and we started our new year in November. It can be said that we, Christians are the spiritual Israelites, and that Israel, especially Galilee where Jesus had ministered as His foothold is a particularly significant place. Jesus instructed the disciples to go all the way to the mountain in Galilee, not to Jerusalem, and told them the Great Commission there. Jesus always speaks to those of us who believe, but when we go to the place where He tells us to go, He has the special words to talk to us at the appointed place. On the 1st of November, in the Lord's day worship service at the shore of the Sea of Galilee, we have been given a scripture from Joshua 5:14: “Neither,” he replied, “but as commander of the army of the Lord I have now come.”

The Lord has been telling us that our mission will be greatly involved in the end-time revival. The scripture given to us in the new year had been told Joshua who listened to and obeyed God completely, and who was about to start taking possession of the land of Canaan, God's promised land. Joshua was the one who trusted the promised word of God, contrary to the 600,000 men in the Exodus. The end-time revival is about to come. God's promise is about to be fulfilled. Let's remember that when we, like Joshua, walk on faith by listening to and obeying the Commander of the Lord, the work of revival and the full-sale fulfillment of His promise will be manifested through us.

Thank you all for your intercessory prayers. All the members of the Egypt-Israel Mission Team came back to Japan safe and sound. The Team left Japan on October 26 and went to Cairo via Amsterdam, visited Mt. Sinai, Eilat, Jericho, spent some time in Galilee and Jerusalem, and came back to Narita/Tokyo on November 7 around one o'clock in the afternoon.

The mission to Israel is organized yearly by the Water Flowing from the Sanctuary Mission. God has been sending a mission from our church every year to Israel which is said to be a model of the Kingdom of God (Heaven). God thus strongly reminds us that we Christians belong to the Kingdom of God, and that we are Heaven's nationals. This time, we were blessed to spend five days in Galilee. There the team was divided into two groups, one going on a tour and the other staying at the hotel to have a fellowship with God in prayer and meditation of the Word by the lake. Galilee is the place where the Lord called out His disciples and started His ministry. Mt. Arbel which is said to be the mountain where Jesus Christ gave the Great Commission to His disciples is also located in Galilee. God leads us to start the New Year in Galilee every year.

This year we saw more signs in Heaven than ever before in forms of thunders, rainbows and rainbow-colored clouds. What was most impressive was that, in Jericho, a rainbow appeared right after we changed buses from a Palestinian bus to an Israeli one, and we headed for Galilee as if we were going through that rainbow. God talked to us through this phenomenon, and gave us the Scripture for this year, Joshua 5:14, "as commander of the army of the Lord I have now come." The Israelites experienced God's blessings, miracles and victories many a time during the forty years they spent in the desert, but nothing happened regarding His Promise of giving them the land of Canaan. Just like the Israelites, we have experienced God's blessings, miracles and victories very often, but have not seen the fulfillment of His promise about the revival in Japan and the End Time Revival in the whole world. God told us that His battle would start for the fulfillment of His promise, the Revival. He also said that, as the Lord came to the Israelites as commander of His army, it is important for us to fight God's battle with Him as our Head, in obedience to Him.

During the mission, an early morning prayer was observed from five thirty in the morning in small groups and an evening meeting was held every day. At the evening meetings we worshiped the Lord as a congregation with songs from the ninth volume of the Yasuragi songs just published by the River in the Desert Music, and some worship groups also offered special praises from that book. In His strong presence, God talked to us in messages and prophecies through Pastor Akimoto and the elders of our church present in the team.

The whole team worshiped the Lord at the foot of Mt. Sinai where the first Tent is said to have been pitched by the Israelites, by the Sea of Galilee, on Mt. Arbel where the Great Commission is said to have been given, and on Mount Olives. But unfortunately we were not able to go up Mt. Hermon known as the Mountain of Transfiguration as usual because the ski lifts were not in operation due to bad weather conditions.

I would like to conclude this report saying how grateful I am to the Lord and also to you all who interceded for us for having returned home with a lot of words, grace and blessings from the Lord without major injuries, accidents or diseases. I heartily appreciate your precious prayers. They were richly answered, and we the team could bring back the Lord's wonderful blessings.

In Egypt, I was led Mt. Sinai climbing up. During the climbing, some were allowed to break down thier physical condition. In our unison prayer of healing, we felt deep presence of the Holy Spirit, and all of us could safely climb up to the summit. While in the mountain, I continuously felt some mysterious power, which was surely the Lord's protection. In various increasing dangers, I was led to concentration of praising and praying, which I individually, too, accept that the Lord is telling me to walk such a way. And as soon as climbing down from the mountain, upon turning back, I saw the appearance of rainbow-colored clouds, to my true surprise. Praise the Lord!

In the team's charismatic meeting I was given the service of piano playing. But, at one time, I made a big mistake in playing and mentally sank at the stretch. "Ah! But I thank the Lord." However,

Further, the Lord spoke to me through the mouth of a church worker, saying, "I often question if I can truly minister. In it I stand on faith that since the Lord himself has made me

stand I can by the Lord.” And I could regain my footing. From there my walk became that of hold on and rely on the Lord desparately. Later on, too, I became protected though struggling with my weakness. And, in the last charismatic meeting, I could play those tunes for which I had completely no conviction by relying on the Lord and in standing on faith. In these series of service I have learned great things. Thinking that since I can play introduction and code, it will be okay, I believed my ability somewhere. Becoming aware of this, I knew that I have no power. And the Lord spoke to me again before and after the new year that in spite of how powerless we are, if the Lord speaks and chooses, the Lord himself will surely accomplish it and we can gain victory with faith.

In the new year message, through “As commander of the army of the Lord I have now come,” (Joshua 5:14) God spoke to us as follows: walk of occupation will finally begin, in which we will see the fulfillment of the promise, and from now on we will be fighting against wall of impossible. We will do the work and the fight of faith thoroughly obeying the Lord. We will progress on the way which we can never progress with our own power but by solely the Lord’s power. I knew later that I had received exactly this learning and showing in my service, too. I thanked the Lord.

At the Sea of Galilee, concentrated praying was led, and I prayed for the intercession of the team, the Prayer House and the showing on myself. All five days, rain fell and stopped but there was deep holy presence by the lake. By being there only, I

Thinking of revival and reading the Books of Gospel and praising each one of the works of many healings and miracles which the Lord did in Galilee, I continued to thank for having received the anointing in advance.

For Israel, it was the rain of grace. The team was with really much rain, but it stopped when the charismatic meeting was started and the sun appeared in the new year worship. The weather was supported on important occasions. God showed us signs after sings: rainbows, rainbow-colored clouds, thunder, and really red evening glow. As I had heard testi-

monies about heavenly signs the Lord often shows our flock, I felt and was moved that really the Lord is showing by the heavenly signs that He is with us.

Really, the Lord is great. Surely, many treasure were buried in this trip. I heartily praise the Lord. I appreciate from my heart your precious prayer of intercession for the team.
